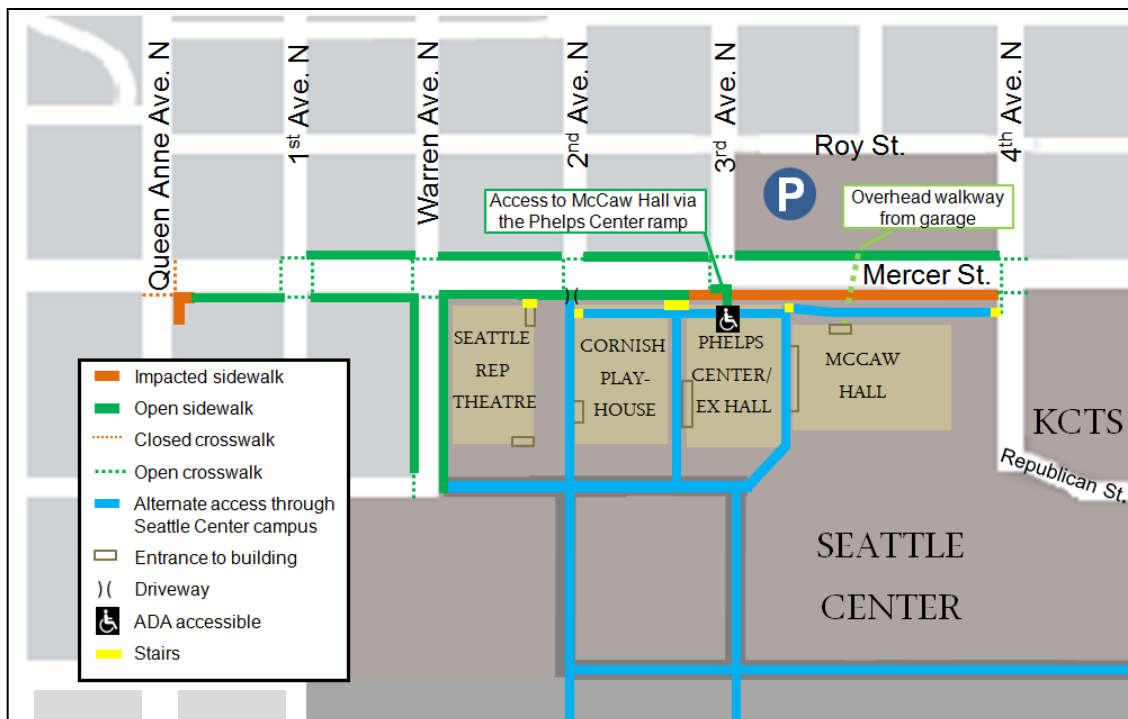

The sidewalk along the south side of Mercer St. between 3rd Ave. N and 4th Ave. N is currently closed for sidewalk removals and conduit installation. Updated detour information will become available as work conditions change.

Anticipated conditions (through March 2):

- The sidewalk on the south side of Mercer St. will be partially closed between 3rd Ave. N and 4th Ave. N.
- Access to McCaw Hall will be open via the north side of Mercer St. and via the crosswalk at 3rd or 4th avenues or from the Mercer Garage via the overhead walkway on level C. *For your safety, please follow detour routes and cross the roadway at designated crossings.*
- Pedestrian routes will be detoured and advanced signage will be posted.
- Passenger drop-off and loading near McCaw Hall on the south side of Mercer St. will be permitted to the west of 3rd Ave. N.
- Local access to businesses, venues and adjacent properties will be maintained at all times.
- Work hours will be approximately 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
